

French speaking Education Event presenter - End-of-Life(EoL) Choices/Medical assistance in Dying (MAID), Advance Health Care Planning(AHCP) presenter Ottawa Chapter

Reports To

EoL Choice/MAID Director, and collaborates with AHCP Director

Position Overview

Remain up-to-date on relevant legislation and policies, deliver presentations (alone, or with one or more team members) on EoL Choices/MAID in French & possibly English, and Advance Health Care Planning (AHCP) workshops in French, as requested by community organizations, or as initiated by chapter (6-8 times/year).

Key Responsibilities

- Ensure with Directors (MAID and AHCP) that statistics and data (MAID statistics for example) are accurate and current prior to each presentation.
- Ensure any changes made to English slide decks are translated into French (with primary translator of slides and notes).
- For EoL Choices/MAID presentations, if presenter does not have personal experience with MAID death, presenter will source a volunteer who has, to present this section.
- Tailor presentation to audience/format/time available if necessary.
- Maintain expertise on legislation, process, changes to Ontario Advance Directives, Substitute Decision laws, etc. to be able to respond to questions.

Supports

- Updates of information from Chapter MAID and AHCP Directors and DWDC national office
- Online information pertaining to legal decisions, process changes, issues, etc.

Time Commitment

- Preparation is anywhere from 1-2 hours, depending upon audience, updates, etc.
- Delivery for EoL/MAID presentations is 1-1 ¼ hours, with question period of approximately 15 minutes. For AHCP workshops 2-2 ¼ hours with 15-20 min. for questions
- Up to 6-8 presentations/workshop per year, usually in spring, fall, winter, and usually during the day

Length of Appointment

- Minimum 2 years

Qualifications

- Knowledge of MAID history, legislation, eligibility, process, issues
- Knowledge of status of Advance directives and laws related to Substitute Decision/Power of Attorney
- Strong presentation & communication skills
- Willingness to immerse self in topic
- Empathy
- French-speaking or bilingual
- Familiarity with Zoom as a presentation platform

Working conditions

- Home Based
- Able to travel to presentation location for in-person events
- Computer with camera and microphone
- Good internet connection

Screening requirements

- Interview(s) with Chapter Chair and French speaking team member
- Reference Checks
- Criminal Record Check
